



## **RISK ASSESSMENT:**

### ***What are the risks to personal safety for people using the school grounds??***

Below is a **RISK ASSESSMENT** template. It is similar to the risk assessments that your teachers have to complete every time they take you out of the classroom. As you walk around the school grounds, see how many problems you can identify that might cause a risk to the personal safety of people who are using the school grounds. One example has been given to start you off.
